

Introduction to HTML

Course Objectives:

This course is designed to equip the user with a proficient grasp of the fundamentals of web page design using Hyper Text Mark-up Language. It will clarify terms associated with web design and discuss factors that influence the way in which your page is displayed. You will work through practical examples using HTML and a basic text editor, designing your own web page. The course concludes by showing delegates how to manage hyperlinks and publishing the page on the Internet.

Course Contents

Introduction	What is the Internet; introduction to HyperText Markup Language (HTML); defining terms associated with web design.
Web Design Issues	Text flow; compatibility issues; page size and content; designing from experience.
Getting Started	Discussion of HTML tags; Basic HTML tags; entering text; correcting mistakes; formatting text; previewing and saving a page.
Page Setup	Giving the page a title, formatting the background of pages with images and colours and setting standard colours for text.
Images	Including images on pages and setting properties.
Hyperlinks	Creating hyperlinks; editing hyperlinks; tracing hyperlinks; checking hyperlinks.
Tables	Entering text; moving around tables; formatting.
Publishing the Web	Uploading the Web site.

Course Details This is a one-day introductory course running from 9:30 am - 4:30 pm. Courses run at both Swansea and Cardiff locations.

Prerequisites To gain the maximum benefit from this course, an attendee should have a basic knowledge of Windows and be able to use the mouse.
